Concord School Board Elections 2018

The filing period for candidates for the Concord School District Board of Education will open on Friday, September 7, 2018 at 8:30 a.m. and will close at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 17, 2018.

Three members of the Concord School Board, the District Clerk and the District Treasurer will be elected at large within the City of Concord, and one member will be elected from Voting District B, Wards 5, 6, & 7.

The terms of Clint Cogswell (at large), Nathan Fennessy (at large) and Maureen Redmond-Scura (at large) are ending December 31, 2018. The final year of Jennifer Patterson (District B: Wards 5, 6, 7) will be open for January 1, 2019 – December 31, 2019. The one-year position is open because School Board President Jennifer Patterson will be moving back to East Concord and is resigning her seat which elected her from Wards 5, 6, and 7.

The terms of School Board Clerk Roger Phillips (at large) and District Treasurer Kass Ardinger (at large) are ending December 31, 2018.

The election will be held on November 6, 2018 and each elected at large member will serve a three (3) year term, beginning January 1, 2019.

The filing fee for candidacy is five dollars (\$5.00).
