

Concord School District Policy #540.1
School Wide Behavioral Interventions and Supports

The Concord School Board is committed to creating learning environments that prepare students to be successful citizens in the 21st century.

All Concord schools shall implement effective behavior intervention and support systems that use a proactive, positive, skill building approach for teaching and learning of successful student behaviors. Emphasis is placed on prevention of problem behavior, development of pro-social skills, and the use of data-based problem solving for addressing existing behavior concerns.

Each school shall establish a set of universal expectations for behavior, positively stated, for all students in all locations of the school. These expectations should promote core values of respect, responsibility, and safety.

Each school shall implement interventions and strategies to teach and reinforce these expectations.
