# TOURNAMENT RULES

Tournaments are open to any AMATEUR golfer who is a resident of Concord or any golfer who is a member of/maintaining an active GHIN handicap at one of the six surrounding clubs: Beaver Meadow Golf Course, Canterbury Woods Country Club, Concord Country Club, Duston Country Club, Loudon Country Club, or Pembroke Pines Country Club. Each participant must have an established GHIN handicap at time of play.

## GUIDELINES FOR REGISTRATION AND TOURNAMENT PLAY

1. Fill out all entry forms with complete and accurate information. Incomplete applications may not be accepted.
2. Applications received after the deadline will be wait-listed at the discretion of the Committee.
3. All events will be played under USGA rules and local rules.
4. Always play without delay and KEEP UP WITH THE GROUP IN FRONT!
5. Please be considerate of the golf course! Rake the traps, replace divots, repair ball marks - remember you are a GUEST at each course.
6. Proper golf attire required. Check with the host club for details. Soft spikes only.
7. In the event of a gross Championship tie, a sudden death playoff to determine the winner will follow immediately. All other ties will be combined and split.
8. Distance-measuring devices: a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. Use of the device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., elevation changes, wind speed, etc.) is prohibited.
9. Carts are allowed. Call Host Club to reserve.
10. The "HOST CLUB" will make decisions as to any weather postponements. If, by chance, one of the two days of a two-day tournament is rained out and cannot be rescheduled, the tournament will be declared an 18-hole tournament and prizes will be awarded accordingly.
11. Players must post all stroke play tournament scores in accordance with USGA rules unless otherwise notified by the Committee.
12. Your entry fee is used for PRIZES with a portion put toward Interclub operating costs and support of local area high school golf programs. Greens fees are compliments of the host club.
