

You will see that the redactions are color coded so that the legal basis for each redaction is clear.

Yellow represents student information protected by FERPA, RSA 189:67, and RSA 91-A:5, III.

Orange represents confidential information pertaining to an alleged crime against a juvenile, exempt from disclosure under RSA 91-A:5, IV, in addition to student information protected by FERPA, RSA 189:67, and RSA 91-A:5, III.

Blue represents personnel file information, which, after applying the balancing test, remains exempt from disclosure under RSA 91-A:5, IV, and teacher certification records, exempt from disclosure under RSA 91-A:5, V.

Pink represents attorney-client privileged information.

Purple represents emergency preparation information exempt from disclosure under RSA 91-A:5, VI.

Gray represents confidential information about witnesses who cooperated with the investigation, exempt from disclosure under RSA 91-A:5, IV.

Mint green represents other confidential information whose disclosure would constitute an invasion of privacy, exempt from disclosure under RSA 91-A:5, IV.
